## 2019 HOBBIES AND CRAFT EXHIBIT RULES AND REGULATIONS

### This Exhibit is divided into three divisions:

JUNIOR	K-5 <sup>th</sup> Grade	Pink
INTERMEDIATE	6 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup> Grade	White
ADULT	After 12 <sup>th</sup> Grade	Yellow

### **SECTIONS AND CATEGORIES HAVE BEEN UPDATED: DO NOT USE PRIOR YEAR INFORMATION**

1. Exhibitor must be a resident of Maui County.
2. Exhibitor must not be a professional crafter. A professional crafter is one who makes and sells any particular craft.
3. Items must be made by exhibitor within the fair year and not exhibited in previous Maui fairs.
4. Exhibitor must sign a Participant Waiver and Certification Form that releases the Maui Fair from the liability of damage or theft of exhibited items.
5. Exhibitor must complete an "Exhibitor Entry Form" located on page 7.
  - a. Section 1: Clothing/Fabric Craft/Needlework Craft
  - b. Section 2: Fine Arts/Crafts
  - c. Section 3: Holiday Creations
  - d. Section 4: Hawaiian Creations**
  - e. Section 5: Recycle/Reuse/Repurpose**
6. Small items such as pins, costume jewelry, etc., must be securely mounted on the top left corner of a white 3"x5" index card (or placed in a plastic sandwich bag).
7. Maximum size of display is 18" x 18" x 24". Clothing, blankets, and quilts exempted.
8. All items should be in a flat box or container with your name and division clearly labeled on the outside of the box. The items will be returned to you in the box. **DO NOT BRING LOOSE ITEMS EVEN IF ONLY ONE ITEM IS ENTERED.**
9. No visible names on any item, front or back.
10. Items entered in the **Recycle/Reused/Repurpose** category must be made of at least 50% recycled/reused/repurposed materials.
11. Entries will be accepted at the War Memorial Gym in Wailuku on **Wednesday, October 2, 2019** between 3:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. Early and late entries will not be accepted. Judging will begin at 6:30 p.m.
12. All entries **MUST** be picked up on Sunday, **October 6, 2019** from 7:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Presenting exhibitor's claim stub is required to pick up your exhibit item(s). **ITEMS NOT PICKED UP ON SUNDAY WILL BE DONATED TO A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION.**

## **SECTION 2. Fine Arts/Crafts**

1. Table displays must not be more than 18" x 18" x 24".
2. Glass, ceramic, and porcelain accepted. Please read the waiver carefully. A protective case is recommended.
3. Small items need to be attached to a 3" x 5" index card or placed in a plastic bag.

## Section 5: Recycle/Reuse/Repurpose (New Section)

Recycle/Reuse/Repurpose has been a category in many of the Sections in the past. Rural Life felt this was an important category so we have decided to create a new Section under the sponsorship of **Maui Disposal Company**.

Do you remember growing up with your grandparents where recycle and reuse was a way of life? Cans were not thrown away, they became planters. There were no Ziploc containers – plastic containers or jars that food came in were reused to store leftovers or for giveaways. We have evolved into a disposable society and that has resulted in waste issues. Please put on your thinking caps and develop ideas to recycle and reuse what has become waste products. You will receive extra points for developing products that can be easily duplicated by others and utilize the maximum amount of product, making a difference in material going to the landfill. Let's together, make a difference in Solid Waste Management on Maui!!!

1. Table display must be no larger than 18 x 18 x 24" (this is due to space limitations)
2. Larger items will be displayed in a tent outside of the gym. These items should be weather proof in case of rain that may drift into the tent

4. Photos can be entered along with functional entry if use is not obvious.
5. An index card sharing how product was made to help others reproduce your product will add to the value of your entry

### Judging Criteria Recycle/Reuse/Repurpose items:

All entries will be judged on the following (Judges' decisions are final):

- 10pts. General Appearance and Workmanship  
Finished product neat and clean and a product that people will like to use
- 10pts. Design  
Design can be scaled up or easily duplicated by others
- 10pts. Functionality  
Usefulness of product – how widely will product be used?
- 20pts. Amount of Recyclable product used  
E.g. if Product is entirely made of recyclables it will receive max points
